



Casa del Oro Garden

The Casa del Oro Garden, including the Herb Garden, was inaugurated in 2003. Replacing a parking lot service area, the ornamental garden was created through the combined efforts of the Historic Garden League, Monterey State Historic Park, City of Monterey, Garden Council, and individual donors whose generosity is commemorated on a brass plaque adjacent to the herb garden. Since its inception, the garden has been maintained by the Historic Garden League, a nonprofit dedicated to the maintenance, restoration, preservation, knowledge, and appreciation of the historic gardens and significant historic buildings of Old Monterey.
